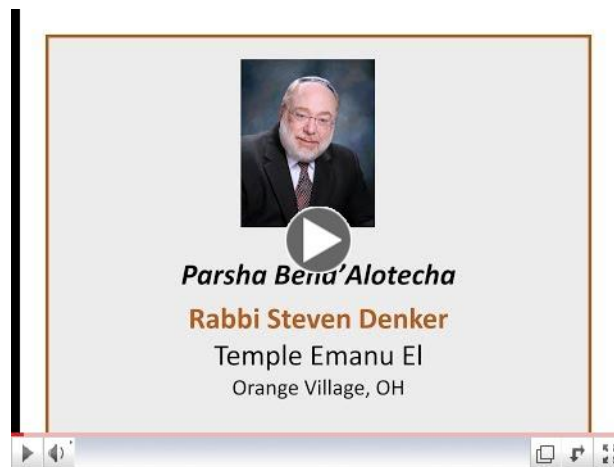

Tragedy Inspires Activism: Parkland Students to Visit TEE

Friday, June 8 ~ 5:45/6:15 pm



Mandi and Harris Jaffe, 16-year-old twins from Parkland, Florida, will share from their hearts their experiences on February 14, 2018 when they spent over 2½ hours managing the stress of a school shooter at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. While navigating the aftermath, Mandi and Harris are continuing to work with classmates on creating change to ensure that this shooting begins a final chapter in these devastating school tragedies. *There will be a Pre-Reception at 5:45 pm followed by a Shabbat service and the presentation. Oneg Shabbat will follow. This event is free and open to the community (not recommended for elementary aged students). Carpooling encouraged.*
